- iOS is only available on 4s onwards. (4s, 5, 5s, 5c, 6 & 6+) **not** compatible with (3G, 3GS)
- iPad—second generation onwards, including mini.
- iPad touch—fifth generation onwards **will** work.
- iPhone 4 can have iOS 7 however it will be incredibly slow.
