CLASS SPOTLIGHT THIS WEEK

- **Foundation Stage** We are have finished writing our Diaries. All the caterpillars have turned into Butterflies and we have now released them into the air. Last week we had a lovely time at our Mini Beast afternoon. We went out onto the field to gather insects on the field.
- **Year 1** have been learning about Emperor Penguins. We have been researching and making our own posters.
- **Year 2** have been writing different poems based on sea creatures. We have done Rhyming Couplets, Personification Poems about the sea, Concrete / Shape poems, Nonsense Rhymes and Riddles where we had to guess the sea creature.
- **Year 3** Maths - finding fractions of shapes and numbers. Literacy - writing letters from WW2 evacuees and Science - investigating changing the pitch and volume of sounds
- **Year 4** have been practically explored capacity, with the children measuring different amounts of liquids. We also learned all capacity word problems to deepen their understanding.
- **Year 5** have looked at features of a diary, planning diary extracts as a character from Pompeii. In Maths we have been multiplying fractions by whole numbers and using tree diagrams to work out prime factors.
- **Year 6** Have been enjoying a new Maths game that helps the children to budget money. The children moving to Crofton Academy and Hemsworth Arts and Community Academy have enjoyed their 'Transition Days'. The children have also been enjoying their work experience in school. Children have been selected daily to work in the office and in Foundation.

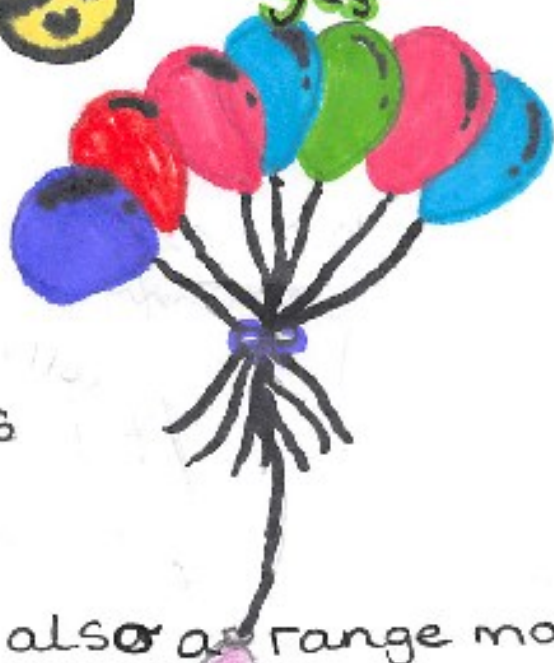
