Dear Parents / Carers

With regards to our visit next week we have received the following advice from Nostell Priory:

- Children and staff will be working in role as wartime evacuees. Ideally, they will wear the outfits worn for VE Day celebrations but should dress for cool temperatures as the house is quite cold inside and at least some of the day will be spent outside. Girls wearing a thin cotton dress would be warmer with a t-shirt underneath and a cardigan or jumper.
- All children should bring a coat.
- All children need to wear sensible flat shoes as the floors are uneven and the children will be climbing quite a few steps. We may also spend some time in the adventure playground.
- Children who need inhalers in cold weather should bring them to school and hand them to a teacher.
- Children will also need a water bottle.
- If the weather is warm/hot. A hat will also be needed and suncream applied in the morning before school.
- FSM will be provided for those children who have them and a packed lunch is required for all other children.

I'm sure the children will have a fantastic day. Yr 3 children go on the 16th June and Yr 4 children the 18th June. The children will be leaving school at 9.00 so we would be grateful if children could arrive for registration at 8.45am and they will be back in school at the end of the day.

If your child brings home a permission letter, please return it to school on Monday. Any children without permission will unfortunately have to stay at school.
